Celebrate Texas student contests are held to promote awareness of Texas Independence Day, the history of Texas and its people and of course for fun and prizes. In order to better serve our History and Social Studies Teachers, we have changed some of our rules, entry qualifications and formats. Please read all instructions carefully.

CELEBRATE TEXAS 2010 **4th GRADE ART CONTEST**

This year's subject is **"My Favorite Texas Animal"**. The student shall draw the picture by hand and color it as they see fit. Computer generated or three-dimensional art will not be accepted. The student is encouraged to label their art. The work must be the student's original work; no copies of existing work shall be considered. The "4th GRADE ART CONTEST" box must be selected. Entries failing to meet the above criteria will not be considered. No hard copy entries will be accepted. The student's name **MUST NOT** be written on the artwork itself.

To enter, the art work should be scanned into a .jpg or .gif format and emailed, along with the completed entry form, to the email address on the entry form.

First place winners from each zone will receive prizes to be announced later on the **Celebrate Texas** website.

CELEBRATE TEXAS 2010 **7th GRADE ESSAY CONTEST**

The subject of this year's essay is **"The Six Flags of Texas" List and Explain the Six Flags of Texas**. The essay must be submitted electronically in 8 1/2" x 11", Microsoft Word (.doc) or plain text (.txt) format. The essay should be in either Arial or Times New Roman, 11 pitch font; contain no photos or graphics and no be greater than two pages in length. The work must be the student's original work; no copies of existing work shall be considered. The "7th GRADE ESSAY CONTEST" box must be selected. Entries failing to meet the above criteria will not be considered. No hard copy entries will be accepted. The student's name **MUST NOT** be written on the essay itself.

To enter, email the essay, along with the completed entry form to the email address on the entry form. First, Second and Third place winners in each of four districts will receive prizes to be announced later on the **Celebrate Texas** website.

CELEBRATE TEXAS 2010 **10th GRADE ESSAY CONTEST**

The subject of this year's essay is **"Texas Declares Independence" Texas declared Independence several times before March 2, 1836. Pick one instance and describe the participants, causes and results.** The essay must be submitted electronically in 8 1/2" x 11", Microsoft Word (.doc) or plain text (.txt) format. The essay should be in either Arial or Times New Roman, 11 pitch font; contain no photos or graphics and no be greater than two pages in length. The work must be the student's original work; no copies of existing work shall be considered. The "10th GRADE ESSAY CONTEST" box must be selected. Entries not meeting the above criteria will not be considered. The student's name **MUST NOT** be written on the essay itself.

To enter, email the essay, along with the completed entry form to the email address on the entry form. First Place winners in each of four districts will be awarded a \$1,000 Scholarship (subject to the Scholarship Award Rules). Second and Third place winners will receive prizes to be announced later on the **Celebrate Texas** website.
